BIO is committed to creating a safe event for all attendees at the 2022 BIO International Convention. With BIO, you can expect that we will follow local and state guidelines, CDC recommendations, and more as it concerns COVID-19 safety. With communication plans in place, all attendees will be notified of attendance requirements and changes as the event approaches. If you are exhibiting cold or flu-like symptoms, have knowingly been exposed to COVID-19, or have received a positive COVID-19 test within 14 days of the start of the event, please stay home and do not attend the 2022 BIO International Convention.

BIO is committed to your safety. Here is what you can expect:

Vaccination Requirements

All attendees (domestic and international), as well as staff, will need to provide proof of vaccination status to gain access to the BIO International Convention.

BIO will be providing multiple ways to show proof of vaccination status. If an attendee or BIO staff member does not meet these requirements, they will be unable to attend the event.

Please note that there may be individual activities or events where additional protocols will be enforced.

Badge Pickup Process

Prior to picking up a registration badge, BIO will verify registrants' vaccination status, photo ID, and health screening questions. Once screened, registrants will be able to pick up their badges at the registration desk or self-serve kiosk.

Mask Requirements

Masks will be required for the 2022 BIO International Convention.

Based on recent CDC updates, masks will be required for all attendees. Learn more here.

COVID-19 Testing
